ORDINANCE NO. 02023-45

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCE NO 2017-18, AS AMENDED; RELATING TO THE TRI-COUNTY SOLID WASTE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT; AMENDING EXHIBIT "B" AND EXHIBIT "C"; ESTABLISHING NEW RATES AND FEES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood, Florida (the "City") enacted Ordinance No. O2017-18 on April 10, 2017 (the "Tri-County Solid Waste Franchise Ordinance" or the "Ordinance"), relating to the granting of a non-exclusive franchise for solid waste collection to serve certain specified properties as further set forth in the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the franchise was granted to Tri-County Sanitation, LLC, Southeast referred to herein as the ("Franchisee"); and,

WHEREAS, Section 11(2) of the Ordinance indicates that adjustments to the approved rates and fee schedule are based on the change to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the previous year and shall not be less than positive two percent (2.0%) or greater than positive four percent (4.0%); and,

WHEREAS, the CPI change from April 2022 to April 2023 was 6.43% which is above the allowed increase range of two percent (2%) to four percent (4%); and,

WHEREAS, the Franchisee is requesting amendments to Exhibits "B" and "C" of the Ordinance to reflect a 4.0% adjustment to the approved rates and fee schedule, which is the maximum increase allowed under the Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City for the Ordinance to be amended as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Wildwood, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND INTENT. The City Commission finds that the above recitals warrant amendment of the Tri-County Solid Waste Franchise Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. The Amended and Restated Tri-County Solid Waste Franchise Ordinance is amended as follows:

Exhibits "B" and "C" of the Amended and Restated Tri-County Solid Waste Franchise Ordinance are hereby replaced by amended EXHIBIT B -RESIDENTIAL RATES and amended EXHIBIT C - COMMERCIAL RATES which are attached hereto. Exhibits "B" and "C" are effective as of October 1, 2023 as stated thereon.

SECTION 3. Except as amended in Section 2 herein, the Amended and Restated Tri-County Solid Waste Franchise Ordinance shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision or portion of this Ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. Unless otherwise stated herein, this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by the City Commission.
