**BOIL WATER NOTICE IN EFFECT!**

**Date:** 08/08/2024

**To:** City of Wildwood

**Impacted Area:** Huey St – from Huey and Warfield going west to Gamble St.

**Includes:** Approximately 8-10 Residential Customers as well as the Wildwood Elementary School

**Excludes:**

**Details:** The City of Wildwood hereby issues a **Boil Water Notice** for the impacted area described above due to a Water Main repair which caused a loss of water or low water pressure. **We suggest that you boil water for the next 48 hours** for precautionary reasons. Once the City has received satisfactory bacteriological samples, the boil water notice will be rescinded.

**\*\*DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST!! Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for at least one minute, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, bathing, and food preparation until the Boil Water Notice has been lifted by the City of Wildwood\*\***
